



## **New Features of ExitCare® version 6.7**

**Macro System** – allows complete information set templates to be stored for repeated common use, including documents, prescriptions, work/school release forms, drug information, etc. These can be saved for Users, Departments, or Facilities.

**Second Custom Footer Area** - Ability for Users to add a custom page footer that always appears at the bottom of each page printed. One use of this is for placement of a bar code at the bottom of each page of the patient information set.

**Fingerprint/Thumbprint Login** – ExitCare now allows for Users to log into the application with a fingerprint reader. This also provided for quick logins by Users authorized to approve the printing of prescriptions. (Requires User supplied hardware/software setup).

**“Copy” watermark** – A repeating large yellow-highlighter style word “Copy” now appears on patient information sets if two or more copies are printed.

**New Audit Item** – Accessing of the Recent Patients system by a logged in User is now an audited event.

**Automatically Print English Copy** - When printing in a language other than English, ExitCare can be set up so that it also automatically prints a second copy of the information in English.

**Patient Birth Date Field Added** – A Patient Birth Date field has been added to the grids for Import Patients, Recent Patients, and Patient Archive functions.

**Search Caregiver Lists by Specialty** – When selecting an attending or follow-up caregiver from the lists, Users can now search by Specialty field (e.g., OB, EENT, Pediatric, etc.).

**Additional Notes Font Setting** – Users can now set up the default Additional Note field font size.

**Add Additional Follow-up Caregiver with Primary Follow-up** – A change has been made to allow for Additional Follow-up providers to be selected/entered, without requiring a Primary Follow-up Caregiver be selected. This allows for listing of a particular Provider to be listed on one information sheet without needing to be listed on all information sheets.

**Generic User Change** – When using ExitCare as “genericuser”, that User Name will now be identified by default in reports, etc. as “Generic User”.

**Security System Saved Passwords** – The minimum number of saved passwords has been changed from zero to one.

### **EXITMEDS NEW FEATURES**

**DEA Number Printing** – A prescriber’s DEA number now prints only on prescriptions for controlled substances.

**Patient Medication Schedule – New Field** – The Patient Medication Schedule (PMS) now includes drug strength information.

**Drug Learning System** - when drug name information is passed into ExitCare, Users can match “incoming drug names” to ExitCare drug names so that they are automatically matched in future imports. This allows different drug databases to work together.

**National Provider Identifier (NPI) Field** – This field has now been added to ExitMeds functions (for prescription writing).

**Medication Reconciliation Clinical Worksheet Change** – When importing drugs from the patient’s drug history, a “Pre-Visit” choice is now available to be checked.

**Start Adding a Drug without Entering Patient Information** – Users can now “create prescriptions” without first adding a patient and caregiver name. However, no prescriptions can be printed out without listing a patient and caregiver name. This change has been made to allow for easier creation of Macros (new feature) which include prescription items.

**Drug Names in Title Case** – To avoid problems of recognizing letters/numbers, drug names now print out in Title Case (first letter of each word capitalized and following letters lowercase), instead of all lowercase as it was previously.

**New Prescription Forms** – A new Rx form has been added for New Jersey to meet that State’s new requirements.

**Drug Interaction Changes** – There is a new Security Option to allow (or not allow) Users to approve Drug Interaction conditions. Also, drug interactions, when flagged, are not disapproved individually on that screen, but require Users to return to the drug tab to make changes if desired.

**Script Archive Date Field** – There is now a data column/field in the Script Archive, allowing users to verify the last date that a prescription was given to the patient.

**Custom Drug List Data Level Choice** – When creating Custom Drug Lists, Users can now create one and assign a “Global Department” level to it. This would allow for multi-facility groups to create this list to be available to, for example, all the ED’s in all of the connected facilities.
